Agency Members - This class shall consist of publicly funded transit providers operating or providing any form of organized public transportation service within the state of Oklahoma. This class also includes any entity operating or providing any form of organized public transportation service within the state of Oklahoma for or in relationship to any public institution or university. Agency members shall have the privileges and services of the Oklahoma Transit Association as prescribed by the Board. The Agency member may be represented by more than one person provided any representative has a practical affiliation to the Agency member. ***The minimum dues amount for transits with less than 10 vehicles is \$1,000. The maximum cap for transits with more than 75 vehicles is \$7500. The dues formula used for all other transits is \$100 x total number of vehicles (see page two for dues formula)***

Affiliate Members - The class shall consist of any provider operating or providing any form of organized public transportation service within the state of Oklahoma whether such provider is affiliated with an Agency member or not. Affiliate members shall have the right to attend meetings, privileges of the floor, and services of the Oklahoma Transit Association as prescribed by the Board. The Affiliate member may be represented by more than one person provided any representative has a practical affiliation to the Affiliate member. ***(\$1000)***

Associate Member - The class shall have the right to attend meetings, privileges of the floor, and services of the Oklahoma Transit Association as prescribed by the Board. The Associate member may be represented by more than one person provided any representative has a practical affiliation to the Associate member. This class shall consist of: Persons, firms or corporations engaged in, manufacturing for, or supplying materials or rendering services to the public transportation field; or Professional consultants or consulting firms that are engaged in professional transportation work. ***(See attached options and select your preferred tier on page 2)***

Partner Members - The class shall have the right to attend meetings and receive services of the Oklahoma Transit Association as prescribed by the Board. The partner member may be represented by more than one person provided any representative has a practical affiliation to the Partner member. This class shall consist of non-profit organizations, educational entities, community groups, or public agencies active in the development, promotion or operation of any form of organized public transportation service that do not qualify under other membership categories. ***(\$500 annually)***

OTA Active Membership Dues:

Agencies are responsible for self-reporting their vehicle numbers annually on Jan. 1 to calculate dues. **Dues are assessed at \$100 per vehicle, with a minimum dues of \$1000 (for less than 10) and a maximum dues amount of \$7500 (for more than 75.)**
